Ghalamkar, "the king's garden," from the 19th century, probably of Ispahan origin, in beige cotton, with print block prints, the decor is incredibly rich, like a tree of life, a paysley motif surrounded by dense floral arabesques, of birds of paradise and Persian calligraphy patches, one with a lion and a sun, symbol of Persia. Alas, there are no more colors and many sunburn spots, the cotton remains in good condition.
