Dax Pottery Market A charming painting that vividly depicts a Dax pottery market, bustling with people amid an abundant display of pottery, jars, dishes, and terracotta objects. The artist captures the warm atmosphere of the markets of southwestern France with great spontaneity: the silhouettes of the potters and passersby stand out in a lively composition, while the numerous ceramic objects occupy the foreground and provide the palette with a succession of ochre, red, orange, and brown earth tones. The brushwork is free, generous, and particularly expressive. A few splashes of red punctuate the clothing and pottery, giving the whole scene a lovely sense of movement and a genuine feeling

of life. This work possesses the charm of regional scenes painted in the mid-20th century, when artists sought to depict markets, traditional crafts, and that southern way of life still deeply steeped in its artisanal traditions. The artist Geneze, signed here with this name, remains largely undocumented today. Research into this surname nevertheless reveals a particularly strong presence in the Southwest: the name Geneze/Genèze is well documented in the Landes and Pyrénées-Atlantiques departments, notably in the Dax, Soustons, Hastingues, Peyrehorade, and Saubusse. Genealogical databases thus list numerous occurrences of the surname in the Landes and around Dax, though they do not yet allow us to identify with certainty the artist represented by this signature. This geographical proximity makes the hypothesis of a regional painter with ties to the Landes region particularly appealing, but we prefer to treat this as a cautious attribution rather than attributing to him a biography that is not documented. In any case, this work demonstrates a particularly sensitive perspective on the world of Dax potters, with a style that is at once spontaneous, warm, and highly decorative. A small painting brimming with Landes charm, which will captivate viewers as much for its subject as for its beautiful painterly texture and warm color palette.
