Description

A beautiful original color lithograph by Jean Hugon (1919-1990), depicting a highly stylized seascape filled with sailboats. Here, the artist creates a particularly luminous composition, dominated by shades of blue, green, turquoise, orange, and yellow, rendered in a highly graphic and decorative style. Artist's proof 1/35, signed in pencil by the artist on Arches paper. This copy is enhanced by a handwritten dedication by Jean Hugon to Raymond Gangloff, artist and ceramicist: "To Mr. Raymond Gangloff, in memory of the warm welcome for my exhibition" A particularly interesting piece due to its decorative quality, its limited edition, and above all, this named provenance and original dedication. Jean Hugon (Marseille, 1919 - Bordeaux, 1990) was a French painter and

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lithographer, particularly renowned for his seascapes, harbors, and sailboats, rendered in a personal pictorial style where the simplification of forms is accompanied by a vivid and luminous palette. His work is part of 20th-century French artistic creation and remains particularly associated with the maritime world of the Atlantic coast and the Southwest. A few slight marks on the corners, slight foxing at the bottom (see photos). Shipped rolled in a tube or available for pickup in Belgium (Brussels or Namur).
