The Khadga is the flaming sword of wisdom of Manjushri, the bodhisattva of wisdom in Buddhism. Here, the blade is made of iron and richly adorned with bronze parts. The hilt features an openwork Vajra design, a grimacing mask at the base of the blade, and the end adorned with a flamboyant motif. Fine quality, with a patina from wear and use--an authentic piece!
