The Virgin, with a serene expression, wears a veil and is draped in a mantle with deep, voluminous folds crafted with meticulous attention to detail. She holds the Christ Child on her left arm, while her right hand presents a richly ornamented reliquary or vase. The Child, depicted in a lifelike posture, offers a
