Description

Fernand CLAVER (1918-1961) Paris, the Quai aux Fleurs / Flower Market Oil on canvas, signed "F. Claver" in the lower left corner. A beautiful Parisian scene executed in a Post-Impressionist style, depicting a Parisian street or square bustling with passersby and a large flower stall in the foreground. Here, the artist favors a vivid, spontaneous, and very luminous style, built up with thick, juxtaposed brushstrokes. The figures are deliberately rendered in a simplified, almost sketchy manner, giving the composition a remarkable sense of movement. The color palette combines the blues, bluish grays, and greens of the architecture and sky with the much warmer tones of the clothing and, above all, the reds, pinks, yellows, oranges, and whites of the flowers. This chromatic contrast is one of the

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work's main decorative attractions. Parisian architecture occupies the upper part of the composition: historic facades, rooftops, a bell tower, and buildings stand out against a slightly misty backdrop. The rendering of light and reflections on the ground evokes a bustling Paris, likely after the rain, with the silhouettes of passersby reflected in the pavement. The signature "F. Claver," clearly legible in the lower left corner, matches the signatures found on Fernand Claver's works. Comparable works by the artist specifically depict scenes of Paris and flower markets.
