Description

"Innocence" engraved by Bervic, after a painting by Léonor Mérimée registered on the 19th of Germinal, Year VI circa 1798. Note at the bottom: Société des Amis des Arts. This engraving is approximately 250 years old. Our restorer carefully cleaned it to remove the traces of time. The engraving had several tears in the white margins, as well as within the image itself. These tears have been carefully restored. To strengthen the paper, which had become fragile over time, and to ensure its long-term preservation, the engraving was backed with a fine Japanese paper, using traditional conservation and restoration techniques. Once the engraving is mounted with a mat and framed, these restorations will become virtually imperceptible. We invite you to examine the photographs carefully, as they form an

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integral part of the description and provide a clear indication of the condition of this engraving. The engraver's work is exceptional, and the engraving remains beautiful and very rare. The price of this engraving has been determined taking its condition into account.
