A magnificent piece of antique brocatelle from the 18th century, in a superb deep raspberry hue, featuring a remarkable floral and ornamental design. This precious fabric captivates with the richness of its embossed weave, which brings out the design with subtle contrasts of light. The pattern, composed of large flowers, foliage, palmettes, and stylized plant motifs, is particularly elegant and characteristic of the grand upholstery fabrics of the 18th and 19th centuries. The beautiful, particularly luminous raspberry red color gives this brocatelle an exceptional decorative presence. Depending on the angle of the light, the design appears sometimes darker, sometimes brighter, revealing the full delicacy of the weave. The piece measures a generous 53 cm in width and 242 cm in height.
