St. John the Baptist, 19th-century bronze sculpture with a brown patina. Both the sculpture and the patina are in perfect condition. On the pedestal, there is a reference to the "Colas Mechanical Reduction" (see photo). No foundry mark. Weight: 0.4 kg. Achille Collas (Paris, February 21, 1795 - Paris, March 3, 1859) was a French engineer, engraver, and illustrator, and the inventor, among other things, of a highly successful process for reproducing sculpted objects in reduced scale. Together with the foundryman Ferdinand Barbedienne, he founded the Collas and Barbedienne Company (Paris).
