White Marble Equestrian Sculpture - 19th Century An elegant white marble equestrian sculpture depicting a horse in motion, rendered with refined attention to the musculature, the mane, and the details of the harness. The animal is captured in a dynamic pose, with one front leg raised, lending the composition a pleasing sense of movement. The figure is sculpted in the round and rests on a molded rectangular base, also made of marble, with a smooth finish and proportions that complement the composition. Particularly striking is the rendering of the head, mane, and harness, elements that lend character to the sculpture. A work in the neoclassical style, with a striking decorative presence, suitable for both a classical setting and a more contemporary interior, where it can serve as an elegant
