This dynamic genre scene depicts a circus performance in which a white horse rears up in the middle of the ring. Executed in Fried's characteristic Impressionist style, the composition emphasizes movement, atmosphere, and spontaneity. The artist's original signature is located in the lower right corner. [1] Pál Fried's work is closely linked to the traditions of French Impressionism. He studied at Lucien Simon's academy and under the guidance of Claude Monet. In 1947, he moved to New York, where he taught at an art academy. During the 1950s and 1960s, he worked in Hollywood. Many well-known figures, including Marilyn Monroe,
