



Vuillermet Aînés - 2g Silver-plated Wine Decanter - Château De Chervinges

Description

An elegant silver-plated metal wine pourer, crafted by Vuillermet Aînés in Lyon, identifiable by its maker's mark PEMAJ accompanied by a star. The tastevin also bears the 2G hallmark, indicating a silver plating of 2 grams, as well as a beautiful engraving reading "Château de Chervinges", which lends it a character particularly evocative of the Beaujolais wine-growing heritage. The Château de Chervinges, located in Gleizé, near Villefranche-sur-Saône, has a long history. The estate was notably owned by Mathieu Valleton de Gravillon in the 18th century, and the château was built on his lands in the late 18th century. The property subsequently passed through the hands of several families from Lyon and the Beaujolais region. A beautiful piece for the table

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and wine tasting, both decorative and steeped in historical and winemaking heritage. Its substantial weight of 84 g gives it a satisfying heft in the hand.
