Round dining table (without extension) by the renowned French fine woodworking house Philippe HUREL--a company with over a century of history, built around clean lines inspired by Art Deco and the Bauhaus, Clean lines, with a structure and veneer in high-gloss varnished mahogany, highlighting the wood's superb grain pattern. Large circular tabletop, superb curly grain and very pronounced wood patterns, with a contrasting border around the edge, rests on a sturdy conical central leg (a recurring design choice for the brand to ensure elegant lines), itself anchored to a thick circular base. The absence of corners and the single central leg optimize legroom and make it easier to arrange the chairs. The symmetrical grain of the wood veneer lends a warm, high-end aesthetic. Dimensions:
