Description

A rare and iconic sculpture from an early edition--"Dancer with Ribbon" or "Tourbillon" (Whirlwind)--dating to the Art Deco period (circa 1923) by Pierre Le Faguays (also known as Fayral), a renowned sculptor of the era. It depicts an elegant dancer mid-spin, holding a ribbon between her hands, set upon a stepped Portor marble base. It features a beautiful, nuanced light-green original patina characteristic of early editions. Crafted from "fonte d'art" (art metal)--a material specific to the Le Verrier workshops--the piece bears the incised signature "FAYRAL," the engraving "Made in France," and was produced by the Max Le Verrier workshops.
