



Saint Cloud Earthenware Dish, Late 17th Century.

Description

This very large, circular, deep dish is decorated in the center with floral scrolls, painted in blue on a white background, imitating the designs found on Chinese porcelain brought back to Europe by the Company of the Indies. On the rim, four floral panels are arranged against a latticework background. A wide blue border runs along the edge of the rim, and a frieze of geometric motifs encircles the base of the dish. A similar piece is housed in the Sèvres Museum. In excellent overall condition, it nevertheless has one or two chips in the enamel around the rim. Date: late 17th century. Dimensions: 44 cm
