The neck is finished with four small handles, a particularly elegant detail that gives this piece its character. A very fine example of Charles Gréber's work, here in a particularly appealing size. At 18.2 cm tall, it is similar in size to the small pieces sought after by collectors of Art Nouveau ceramics: a piece that is unassuming in size but remarkable for its shape, glaze, and the finesse of its details.
