A very beautiful table featuring Louis XVI fluted legs ending with castors. Superb proportions that are visually pleasing. The table has 5 solid mahogany leaves with frieze. Both the table and the five extensions have a superb flame. The table and its five mahogany extensions have been hand polished in our workshops. It can therefore be displayed without a tablecloth and features a superb patina. In perfect condition. The height below the
