Georges DEMIRGIAN (1855-1920) View of a coastline with cliffs and perhaps a fort on the right; most likely a location on the Basque coast. Georges Demirgian was a painter of landscapes, portraits, and Orientalist subjects, born on November 28, 1855, in Cairo, Egypt, and died on September 27, 1920, in Arcachon, France. A student at the École des Beaux-Arts under Léon Bonnat and Fernand Cormon, he exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français in 1882, 1889, and 1893. Oil on canvas, 24.5 x 55.5 cm, in fair condition: soiling, marks, minor wear. Original canvas, key-lock stretcher, remnants of a former label on the back.
