Elegant French dresser made of stained wood and woven rattan, crafted by Maison Maugrion around the 1980s--a company renowned for producing high-end furniture under the brand name "Le Rotin Prestige" "This chest of drawers features a wooden frame accentuated by woven rattan panels that cover the top, sides, and fronts of the three large, functional drawers. The molded frames, stepped base, and round wooden knobs give the piece a particularly refined finish. The interior of the drawers is made of varnished wood. The piece bears its "Maugrion - Le Rotin Prestige" label, visible on the back, attesting to its origin. Maison Maugrion, founded in Bayeux by Roger Maugrion around 1960, specialized in the French manufacture of high-quality rattan furniture. Its designs were notably distributed

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through the Roche Bobois network during the 1970s and 1980s.
