It rests on a rectangular base supported by four small feet. Four columns, each featuring a base and capital in gilded bronze, define the structure of the clock. The enameled dial is framed by a lovely bronze border. Beautiful floral pendulum in gilded bronze. The clock is in working order, but the movement could benefit from cleaning.
