Description

A very rare bas-relief made of plaster based on a 2nd-century Roman sarcophagus housed at the Louvre Museum (Inventory Number: MR 885) and depicting a featuring Nereids, tritons, centaurs, and sea horses. An exact replica of the original work, suitable for use as a wall-mounted console or as a freestanding piece. Can also be used as a wall bas-relief by removing the base. 19th-century cast (natural hemp and iron), likely from the Louvre workshops for a special commission. A very rare piece for a one-of-a-kind decoration. Very good overall condition, very few missing pieces, slight wear and patina.
