Description

A rare fragment of late Gothic craftsmanship from 15th-century France, this carved oak panel reveals the architectural poetry of medieval tracery. The design features intersecting pointed arches and quatrefoil motifs, deeply sculpted into the aged wood with remarkable precision. Its surface bears the marks of time, a rich, dark patina and traces of historic woodworm, all professionally treated, that testify to centuries of survival.

Originally part of a larger ecclesiastical or domestic furnishing, the panel embodies the spiritual geometry and artisanal mastery of the Gothic era. The rhythmic interplay of line and void evokes cathedral windows in miniature, making it a compelling decorative relic and study
