A beautiful gilded bronze animal sculpture depicting a hunting dog in an alert and expressive pose. The sculpture bears the incised signature "A. DUBUCAND" as well as the foundry mark "E.V. 831" on the pedestal. Alfred Dubucand (1828-1894) was a French animal sculptor renowned for the quality and realism of his depictions of animals, particularly dogs and hunting-related subjects. He exhibited regularly at the Paris Salon between 1867 and 1883. A French work from the last third of the 19th century. Dimensions: height 11 cm × length 12 cm × depth 5 cm
