Description

A very beautiful and original interior design rendering depicting a spacious convention hall or reception area, likely created as part of a hotel or conference center project from the 1960s. The composition depicts a particularly lively interior: a bar area, tables and armchairs, decorative plants, lighting fixtures, large windows, and numerous figures. The inscription "CONGRES," visible above the bar, confirms the likely purpose of this space. The work reflects the approach to presenting architectural and interior design projects of this period, with significant attention to volumes, lighting, furniture, and the flow of people. Technique: pencil drawing, colored with watercolor, and highlights likely applied in gouache on tracing paper. Date: circa 1960-1970. Dimensions: 61 × 46 cm. Condition: shows signs
