A drawing by Franz von Stuck (1863-1928), a leading German Symbolist painter and one of the founders of the Munich Secession. This sketch is a classic example of the master's academic drawing style. The work presents a detailed and expressive rendering of a powerful male torso in a dynamic twist. This piece serves as a preparatory study for a centaur figure intended for one of the artist's most famous large-scale paintings: "The Battle of the Centaurs" (1894), the original of which is currently held in the Städel Museum's collection.
