Description

Oil on canvas depicting a lively seascape with fishermen in stormy weather along the Neapolitan coast. In the foreground, several figures watch as the boats arrive, caught in a heavily choppy sea. The composition is dominated by the movement of the waves and spray, rendered with vigorous brushwork, beneath a stormy sky. The painting bears a barely legible signature in the lower right corner, accompanied by the inscription "Napoli." Through its subject, composition, and style, this work fits into the tradition of Neapolitan landscape and seascape painting from the first half of the 19th century, developed notably around the Posillipo School. We propose a date of around 1850, likely within the 1830s-1850s, though it has not yet been attributed to a specific artist. The scene still retains a

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romantic sensibility, particularly evident in the dynamic rendering of the sea and the lively activity of the fishermen in the foreground. Presented in a beautiful antique wooden frame with gilded stucco and a palmette design. Neapolitan School, first half of the 19th century. Circa 1850. Signed and inscribed "Napoli" in the lower right corner.
