A beautiful painting from the late 19th century or early 1900s that depicts a delicate oil study of a seated monk ...The work is unsigned but bears on the reverse the stamp of the art dealer " Maison Merlin Paul Denis Succ. ," which was located at 19 Rue Médicis in Paris: this dealer operated between 1861 and 1905 and counted among the artists who supplied artists as prestigious as Alphonse Mucha, Giovanni Boldini, Lucien Simon, Giuseppe De Nittis, as well as Georges Moreau de Tours(1848-1901) : It should be noted that the latter could be an excellent suspect, as several studies can be found online executed in a very similar technique, objectively speaking--a tip for research enthusiasts...
