The frame features abundant ornamentation of foliage scrolls, acanthus leaves, volutes, and plant tendrils, arranged in a dynamic and particularly decorative composition. The corners are adorned with large foliage motifs, while the crossbars and stiles are enlivened by scrolls in relief. The deep, openwork carving is highlighted by beautiful antique gilding with a brown patina, revealing subtle contrasts between the raised elements and the background. The mirror retains its original glass, which displays the characteristics of an antique mirror, with a beautiful patina and slight signs of wear due to its
