Jean DROIT - Wagram Pharmacy. Stunning Art Deco watercolor on thick vellum (drawing: 250 x 200 mm - Margins: 350 x 280 mm). It is signed in the upper left corner. This watercolor was published by Laboratoires Pépin & Leboucq in a promotional portfolio of 8 sheets titled "Les Pharmaciens d'autrefois" (Pharmacists of Yesteryear); this particular sheet depicts the period of the Third Republic under President Lebrun. This original is inscribed on the mat to Dr. Leboucq, one of the founders of the laboratory responsible for this publication. Jean Droit, born on August 28, 1884, in Laneuveville-devant-Nancy (Meurthe-et-Moselle, France) and died on December 7, 1961, in Vincennes, was a French painter, illustrator, and writer, and the father of Michel Droit.
