Meissen porcelain figurine from the "Cris de Paris" series, Lemonade Seller (Limonadenverkäufer). Model designed by Peter Reinicke between 1753 and 1754. Marked with crossed blue swords and numbered 1. In perfect condition. Listed in the Meissen-Bergmann catalogHistory of the Cris de ParisThe practice of street hawking is described there as a public service under the authority of the crown. Men, women, and children would wander the streets, calling out their wares or services to attract customers. Each trade had its own distinctive call. Meissen drew inspiration from these trades and created a series of 34 figurines featuring these characters.
