### Description

A bust portrait of a magistrate depicted in three-quarter profile against a dark background. The subject wears a black judicial robe with a white lapel, a characteristic attire of the judiciary during the reign of Louis XIV and in the early 18th century. His long, curly wig--emblematic of the administrative and judicial elites of the time--signifies his social rank and office. Note: the painting has been re-lined; there is a very small area of missing paint on the cheek (see photo).
