Description

Architectural study model from the second half of the 20th century, illustrating the trend toward organic and cellular utopias. Directly inspired by formal research on bubble dwellings--popularized on the French Riviera by the work of Antti Lovag and epitomized by Pierre Cardin's legendary Palais Bulles-- this architectural complex breaks free from traditional orthogonal volumes in favor of fluid, biomorphic forms. The composition features a modular village structured by glazed terracotta domes in earthy tones, punctuated by characteristic porthole-like openings. The ensemble is set against a textured landscaped base incorporating walkways and terraces.
