Description

2 Satsuma vases decorated with the "Thousand Faces" motif. Identical polychrome vases made of gilded ceramic and their cylinders. The vase is decorated with Lohan, enlightened disciples of the Buddha whose spiritual mission is to protect Buddhist teachings. The relief details and textured effects of the gilding and clothing were created using the moriage technique. This technique involves applying liquid clay to the vase before gilding and painting it, thereby creating a superb three-dimensional effect. Marked "Seizan" on the bottom, the name of a traditional potter. Slightly weathered at the top and bottom, but with no chips; overall, in very good vintage condition. 15 cm wide at the base, 13 cm wide at the top, 38 cm tall. Early 20th-century Japanese craftsmanship (Taisho or Showa period).
