Chinese porcelain lidded jar with polychrome decoration - Late 19th century
Elegant circular lidded jar made of Chinese porcelain, featuring a rich, hand-painted polychrome decoration. The body and lid are adorned with lively scenes depicting various figures in landscapes featuring architecture, trees, rocks, and vegetation. A calligraphic inscription accompanied by a small red seal appears on one of the sides. The slightly domed lid is topped with a floral-button-shaped handle, partially highlighted in gold. Gold bands accentuate the rims. A red six-character seal mark is present on the base. Chinese work, likely made in the late 19th or early 20th century, circa 1880-1910. In good overall condition considering its age. Wear to the gilding, minor firing imperfections, and signs of use visible in the
