An elegant pair of lidded vases in cobalt blue porcelain in the Sèvres style, adorned with gilded bronze mounts and hand-painted gallant scenes. Each vase features a deep cobalt blue background, richly decorated with gilded motifs of scrollwork, foliage, and rocaille-style ornaments. The main cartouches are decorated with romantic scenes in the 18th-century style, depicting couples in garden landscapes, inspired by the spirit of the gallant scenes of Watteau and Boucher. The vases rest on gilded bronze bases and are embellished with finely crafted side handles, metal borders, and lids topped with pine cone-shaped knobs. The set offers an elegant and refined decorative presence, typical of the French style inspired by Sèvres porcelain. This pair is likely a mid-20th-century piece, crafted in the
