Description

Oil on canvas in its original painted wooden frame in the Moorish style. Work by Louis-Édouard Brindeau de Jarny (1867-1943), known as Brindeau, an Orientalist painter, founder and first director of the École Supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Casablanca and of the Association of French Painters and Sculptors in Morocco. Here he depicts a beautiful scene featuring figures crossing paths in an alleyway, using light to enhance the architecture and vegetation in the foreground. The painting is in good overall condition, with a very slight indentation in the canvas--barely visible--in the center, and a small loss of paint in the lower right corner.
