A cameo glass vase by Établissements Gallé--the firm founded by Émile Gallé (1846-1904)--featuring a slender form with a long, slightly tapering neck rising from a widely flared base. The decoration, characteristic of the Gallé firm's Art Nouveau output, displays an elegant botanical motif of stylized leaves and stems, executed using the acid-etching technique against a light, nuanced background. The color palette is notably soft and harmonious, blending tones of brown, purplish-brown, pale green, and opalescent white to create beautiful depth effects that shift with the light. The design extends across the body and up the neck, showcasing the layering and contrast typical of Gallé glassware from the early 20th century. Signed "Gallé" in
