A traditional Papuan bag called "bilum," made from braided plant fibers and rooster feathers in this particular example. Every Papuan, whether man or woman, has their own bilum for carrying food, tobacco, betel nuts, amulets, and more. This particular piece, typically reserved for display during traditional ceremonies such as weddings, is entirely decorated with feathers.
