Description

Plaster casts created by Antonio Carminati, a Milanese artist active at the second half of the 19th century. Antonio Carminati was a sculptor of considerable importance who favored bronze casting as a means of expressing his art, which often involved the depiction of female figures. These objects are plaster casts used to create his bronze works using the lost-wax casting process. The dimensions of the objects are as follows: the standing lady is 65 cm tall, her base measures 25 x 27 cm, and the bust is 28 cm tall. A certificate of authenticity is included with the sale.
