Description

An elegant seascape painted in oil on canvas around 1900, depicting a bustling harbor filled with sailboats and small vessels. The composition is dominated in the foreground by an imposing three-masted sailboat, moored in a calm basin whose surface reflects the boats and structures along the wharf. In the background, low-rise harbor architecture stretches out, punctuated by masts, buildings, and the silhouettes of boats. The artist favors a luminous palette of blues, grays, and sandy tones, particularly evocative of the maritime atmospheres of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. The loose, vibrant brushwork sensitively captures the effects of light on the water and the sky. This stamp serves as an indication of origin or provenance, though it does not, on its own, allow the work to be attributed with certainty to a Viennese artist. A decorative and luminous work, characteristic of the taste for seascapes of the Belle Époque, which will easily find its place in a classic or contemporary interior.
