Description

Large decorative ceramic bowl with a wavy, petal-shaped rim (kiku-gata--a stylized motif representing chrysanthemum petals). Made of Satsuma-style ceramic (stoneware) with a characteristic, finely crackled ivory-colored glaze. Richly decorated with multicolored glazes and dense gilding (moriage and applied gold). The main scene depicts two picturesque birds of paradise perched on a branch of a cherry tree in bloom (sakura). All around, a geometric honeycomb pattern (kikko) with gilded medallions (mon) alternating with plant motifs (flowers, butterflies). On the reverse, a richly gilded rim and border, adorned with floral motifs, butterflies, and round medallions featuring gilded relief patterns.
