Description

Roger Dumax, born in 1930 in Paris, is a painter who works primarily in watercolor and is known for his Provençal landscapes. Here, on a large canvas one meter long, he chose to depict the harbor of the charming village of Saint Chamas in 1967. In the foreground are large boats--the famous "pointus"--with fishermen hard at work while others unload their catch of the day in front of a welcoming bistro with its umbrellas and wide red awning. In the middle ground are fishermen's houses and small apartment buildings, and behind them, the bell tower of the 18th-century Saint-Léger Church. Finally, in the background, the Baou hill. Painted with a knife and a broad brush in successive strokes of vivid, nuanced colors ranging from the blue-green of the sea to the blue of a barely overcast Provençal

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sky. Oil on canvas, signed lower right "R.
DUMAX," located in St. Chamas and dated 1967.
