Description

The scene depicts a comfortable bedroom within an aristocratic home. These are interpretive prints from the 18th century--specifically, "Le Coucher" (Going to Bed) and "Le Lever" (Rising)--based on designs by Sigmund Freudenberg (known as Freudeberg); they were etched by Louis Desplaces and finished with the burin by Louis Bosse. The engravings belong to a series titled *Monument du costume physique et moral de la fin du dix-huitième siècle* (Monument to the Physical and Moral Costume of the Late Eighteenth Century). Publisher/Original Designer: Jean-Henri Eberts (credited as I.H.E. or I.H.F. *inv.*). Jean-Henri Eberts (1726-1793) was a French banker, art dealer, and engraver. In the 1770s, Eberts was keenly aware of the importance of Parisian fashion creation and the

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international influence it wielded. He conceived a plan to create a series of collectible prints--released in annual installments--depicting the clothing, living environments, and daily activities of the fashionable Parisians with whom he mingled. He designed twelve scenes tracing the course of a fashionable woman's day, wrote the accompanying texts, and commissioned the young Sigmund Freudenberg (known as Freudeberg) to execute the engravings. The first set of prints--intended to document the history of manners and costume in 18th-century France--was published in 1775. Louis Bosse was a French burin engraver active during the 1770s. (Note: Inscriptions appear only on the "Le Coucher" engraving.)
