### Description

This object is an antique silver-plated oil cruet or jug. According to the hallmarks on the frame, this example was produced by the renowned English manufacturer James Dixon & Sons of Sheffield. This type of tableware was particularly popular from the late 19th century to the early Edwardian period (circa 1890-1910). Object characteristics: Function: An elegant case for condiments and spices on the table. The complete set usually includes four or five glass flasks. Contents: Two cut crystal flasks with glass stoppers (traditionally for olive oil and vinegar). A small pot with a silver lid (for mustard). A salt or pepper shaker with a silver stopper (for pepper or salt).

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
