The vase has an elegant ovoid body, a short neck with a thick, rounded rim, and a small circular foot. Its exceptionally small size and rich iridescence make it a particularly interesting piece for collectors of Loetz glassware and Bohemian Art

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Nouveau glass. Condition: The vase is in good vintage condition. The upper rim has a very slight irregularity, likely caused by an air bubble that burst during production rather than by subsequent damage.
