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age, which are normal for an antique fabric, as well as a hole clearly visible in the photographs. Nevertheless, the piece remains highly decorative and makes a striking statement. With its generous dimensions, this panel can be used as-is to drape a wall, create a headboard, a canopy, decorative panels, or--depending on the project--be transformed into an elegant pair of curtains.
