Japanese-style Display Case By Vincent épeaux (1862-1945)

Description

Japanese-style display cabinet made of stained wood, with a glass door; late 19th century. The wider central section is flanked by two side display cabinets. The entire piece features carved decorations of geometric and floral motifs, embellished with openwork mother-of-pearl and gilded bronze inlays. The lower sections are decorated with panels featuring motifs inspired by Asian art, including branches of cherry blossoms. The undulating cornice is adorned in the center with an openwork medallion. The interior, which is illuminated, is lined with red fabric and fitted with four glass shelves. Bears the stamped mark of the Vincent Épeaux PARIS firm: Vincent Épeaux (1862-1945)--a Parisian cabinetmaker close to Hector Guimard and a champion of Art Nouveau.

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He won the silver medal at the 1900 World's
Fair and became the industrial patron of the
Enfants de l'Ébénisterie in 1912. A
beautifully crafted piece, in very good condition.
