An elegant pair of large baluster vases made of Limoges porcelain, featuring a rich, hand-painted polychrome floral design composed of bouquets of roses and other flowers in delicate shades. The vases feature generous highlights of gilding, particularly on the necks, rims, and decorative elements, elegantly accentuating the floral composition and the silhouette of each piece. They bear the signature "Porcelaines d'Art A. Golse - Limoges," characteristic of the art studio of the decorator André Golse (1844-1937), who was active in Limoges. The Golse studio created decorative designs on porcelain produced by various Limoges manufacturers. A particularly elegant decorative pair, representative of Limoges art porcelain production from the late 19th century.
