Given in pairs (the man and the woman), usually as symbolic gifts at weddings, they embody fertility and family happiness. They are generally made of wood and, more rarely, of bronze, as is the case with this lovely piece. In good condition, aside from slight normal wear and tear that does not affect its value. Dimensions: Height 15 (cm). The material has a nice density, resulting in a substantial weight of 570 grams before packaging.
