brushstrokes that define the volume and texture of the plants, with a rendering of light that distinguishes the subjects from the dark-toned background. The work is framed in a gilded frame adorned with ornamental motifs along the edge and outer profile. Charles Swyncop (Brussels, 1895-1970) was a Belgian painter active during the 20th century. Trained at the Academy of Fine Arts in Brussels, he oriented his work toward Post-Impressionist painting, distinguishing himself through his use of light and color. His body of work includes portraits, nudes, interiors, and still lifes. Swyncop participated in national and international exhibitions, maintaining a painterly style faithful to the Belgian figurative tradition, characterized by bold brushstrokes and attention to the textural rendering of his subjects.
